Hotel Car Sticker Guidelines

Davos-Klosters, Switzerland 21-24 January

Hotel car sticker guidelines

General policy

As part of safety and environmental measures, the World Economic Forum – in collaboration with the police – has set high-security and waiting zones that are **restricted to vehicles with selected car stickers**.

A hotel car sticker grants access to the outer security zone of three of the high-security hotels for drop-off and pick-up only and is required and valid from **Sunday 19 January 18.00 until Saturday 25 January 06.00**:

- Hotel Seehof
- InterContinental
- Steigenberger Grandhotel Belvédère

The hotel car sticker **does not** grant access to the following areas as they are in the security zone where access with vehicles is strictly restricted:

- Hilton Garden Inn/Promenade 101 building
- Congress Centre and Kongress Hotel
- Ice Village

Drivers of a vehicle with a hotel car sticker must hold an Annual Meeting or a hotel (driver) badge. Drivers will be able to pick up and drop off passengers only; they are not authorized to enter the high-security hotels.

Which cars are eligible for a hotel car sticker?

The following emission requirements must be met:

- Car (1-7 seats): CO₂ maximum emission rate **204g CO₂/km**
- Van (minimum 8 seats): CO₂ maximum emission rate **258g CO₂/km**

NEW: The CO₂ emission limits refer to the Worldwide Harmonized Light-Duty Vehicles Test Procedure (WLTP) and not to the NEDC test procedure used in past years. These maximal emission requirements do not apply to trucks or vehicles with a capacity of more than nine seats, including the driver.

Cars with CD (diplomatic) plates are exempt from the hotel car sticker emission standards; however, vehicle and drivers need to register in advance through the hotel badge and hotel car sticker platform (access via TopLink or www.davoshotelsecurity.com).

To verify whether your vehicle meets the requirements, please check the following websites (information is available in German, English, French and Italian):

- For vehicles matriculated in Switzerland: Check on the website of the Swiss Federal Office of Energy to receive the vehicle specific energy label. Please note that the CO₂ emission value on energy labels retrieved before or on 31 December 2019 will refer to the NEDC 2.0 (German: NEFZ 2.0) emission values, whereas energy labels as of 1 January 2020 will indicate WLTP emission values. In both cases, the emission limit of 204g/km resp. 258g/km applies. Please upload the retrieved energy label of the vehicle to the registration platform.
- For vehicles not matriculated in Switzerland: Either look up your vehicle here: www.verbrauchskatalog.ch or contact us at carsticker@weforum.org. If a WLTP value cannot be retrieved and the emission value on the vehicle registration document refers to NEDC, a conversion factor of 120% will be applied to the NEDC emission value to check if the vehicle is within the WLTP emission limit (e.g. NEDC = 100g/km, WLTP = 1.2*100g/km = 120g/km).

Who can request a hotel car sticker and a hotel driver badge?

Hotel car stickers and hotel driver badges can only be requested by **official hosts** (see p. 3 on how to become a host).

Hotel car sticker and hotel driver badge online registration

- Hotel car sticker and hotel driver badge online registration via TopLink or www.davoshotelsecurity.com opens on **Friday 29 November**.
- **A one-time fee of 200 CHF per car sticker and 100 CHF per driver badge registration** will be charged to cover production and administrative costs of a hotel car sticker and hotel driver badge; remaining revenues will be fully allocated to carbon offsetting projects. Please note that only credit cards are accepted for payment and this fee is non-refundable.
- The official hosts can verify the status of a hotel car sticker and a hotel driver badge request by accessing their user profile on the registration platform.
- To request a hotel car sticker, the **vehicle registration document must be uploaded** for the Forum to verify that the above-mentioned emission requirements are met. Please be aware that spot checks will be conducted on site.
- For **vehicles with foreign plates** or vehicles that have been **imported to Switzerland**, the **Certificate of Conformity (COC)** has to be **uploaded with the vehicle registration document** for the Forum to verify that the above-mentioned emission requirements are met.

Important: Should you hire a car through a rental car company, please check whether the vehicle and driver have already been registered by the car rental company in order to avoid duplication.

Hotel car sticker and hotel driver badge collection point

A confirmation email will be sent to the official host as soon as the car sticker and the hotel driver badge are approved and ready for pick up at Registration at [Parsenn Parking](#) (Bündaparkplatz, access via Mühlestrasse, 7260 Davos).

Opening hours

- Tuesday 14 January to Saturday 18 January from 08.00 to 20.00
- Sunday 19 January to Tuesday 21 January from 06.00 to 01.00
- Wednesday 22 January to Thursday 23 January from 06.00 to 23.00
- Friday 24 January from 06.00 to 14.00

Please note: Car stickers may not be picked up by persons without a badge. The hotel car sticker must be collected on presentation of the car registration document used to register.

Hotel car sticker placement

The following rules must be followed:

- The hotel car sticker and hotel badge are important security credentials and their misuse may be subject to police and legal action.
- The hotel car sticker must be affixed on the vehicle's interior windscreen as per the following illustration:



Vehicle waiting zone

As waiting zones are not parking areas, the driver must stay in the car with the engine off. If a driver does not comply with the above-mentioned regulations, the car sticker will be irrevocably removed by the police and, according to circumstances, the vehicle may be towed at the owner's expense.

If you are a limousine company and want to register your drivers and cars, the Car Sticker team needs to create an official Host account for you.
